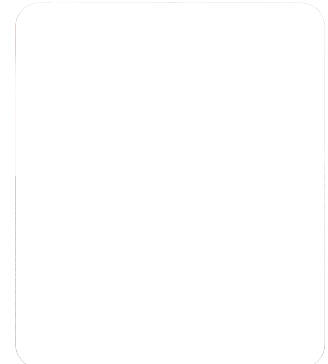

a wire-free world for a simplified life

Imagine being free to connect to the Internet and get to the information you need — from wherever you happen to be. get connected in two easy steps

All you need to tap into the Wi-Fi way of life are a wireless-enabled device and access to a location with a wireless Wi-Fi network.

step 1: select a device that fits your lifestyle and make it mobile

Own a notebook computer or HP iPAQ Pocket PC without wireless capability? All you need to add is a wireless Wi-Fi network card. This credit card-size accessory is like a modem — it allows your device to transmit and receive a wireless network signal that enables you to connect to the Internet. Wi-Fi network cards can be purchased from any leading consumer electronics retailer or online at websites like www.hp.com, and generally come complete with instructions on how to install and use the card.

step 2: find the wireless location that suits you

Many of the public hot spots may require you to set up an account, while others may allow you to connect for free.

Locating a public Wi-Fi hot spot can be easy. Tools found within Microsoft® Windows® XP or free downloadable applications can automatically detect and connect you to wireless networks in your vicinity. If you don't have software to help you automatically detect Wi-Fi networks, you'll need to configure your device to look for the specific network using the "SSID" or network name. If you need help getting set up, your Internet service provider should be able to help.

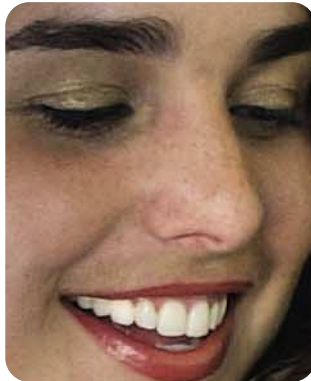
